J'y pense : a study of the French resumptive y

Abstract: The aim of this paper is to show that y, a localizing adverbial pronoun in French, can refer to human, nonanimate, or predicative units when it appears in the segment j'y pense. It targets recurring structures in which j'y pense, taking a resumptive value, refers to predicative units: j'y pense thus appears in temporal infra-sentential segments (quand j'y pense, maintenant que j'y pense, pendant que j'y pense), in the correlative plus j'y pense and in the discursive structure "(mais) j'y pense: predicative unit". These resumptive units correspond to phraseological units by virtue of their fossilised form and display particular discursive values.
